

DOG LICENSE APPLICATION

Licenses are required in the City of Dodgeville for dogs five (5) months and older.
 According to City Ordinance 12.10, there is a maximum limit of 2 dogs per household.

STEPS TO LICENSE YOUR DOG:

1. You **MUST** include a copy of your unexpired rabies certificate with this application. State law requires that the rabies certificate be presented to the Clerk’s office prior to the issuance of a license.
2. Write a separate check or make a separate online payment for your licenses. Checks that include payments for taxes, utility bills or other fees will not be accepted. Checks are payable to “City of Dodgeville”. Please indicate “Dog License” in the memo line.
3. Enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope unless you wish to pick up your licenses. Licenses can be obtained from City Hall at 100 E Fountain St. For questions, call 608-930-9485 or email deputy@dodgevillewi.gov
