

## ANIMAL LICENSES

- Licenses are required for all dogs and cats five months of age or older.
- A copy of the **PROOF OF RABIES** certificate for each pet is required to obtain a license.
- **FEES** are \$6 per neutered/spayed animals or \$15 for each unaltered animal. A **\$25 late fee** will be charged for all licenses issued after March 31st except newly acquired pets.
- You may fill out an **APPLICATION** from our website (type “Animal License” in the Search) or complete and return the form below.
- Write a **SEPARATE CHECK** payable to the “City of Dodgeville” & return to City Hall.

## 2024 RESIDENT BROCHURE

*A New Election Season is Just Around the Corner!*

As we approach the end of 2023, City staff are beginning to prep for the upcoming election cycle. As far as elections go, 2024 will be a big one - culminating with the Presidential Election on November 5th. The Spring Election on April 2nd, will bring the Presidential Preference along with plenty of state and local races.

In 2024, there will also be a big change in how the City of Dodgeville will conduct their elections. The City will be implementing "Badger Books" which replace traditional paper poll books. Badger Books will speed up lines, eliminate human errors, and allow voter participation and election reconciliation to be completed in a timelier fashion. Have no fear, Badger Books have nothing to do with ballots and they are not connected to the internet. You'll still be voting with the traditional or express vote paper ballots.

### DON'T INCLUDE OTHER SERVICE PAYMENTS

This includes pet licenses, utility payments, or other fees due to the City. **Please write separate checks for each service.** If you include more than your property tax payment, your check will be refused & you will be required to issue a new check.

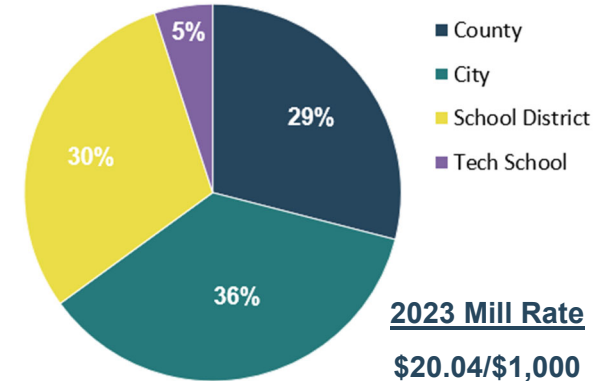
## PROPERTY TAX REMINDERS

- **First installment** tax payments are payable to the City of Dodgeville by January 31, 2024. **Second installment** payments are due to Iowa County by July 31, 2024.
- All personal property taxes, except improvements on leased land, are due in full by January 31st.
- If the total tax due on a parcel is \$100 or less, the full amount is due by January 31st. (See Wis §74.11(7) or §74.12 or §74.5)
- **Failure to Pay On Time** - If you choose to pay your real estate taxes in installments, then you must pay each installment timely or the TOTAL amount of your remaining unpaid taxes, special assessments, special charges and special taxes (if any) will be delinquent (§74.11(7) or §74.12 or §74.87) All delinquent taxes are subject to interest rate of 1% plus .5% penalty rate per month (a fraction of a month counts as a whole month) from Feb 1 until paid. Failure to receive a tax bill does not relieve the obligation of the property owner to pay taxes.
- **Escrow Payments**—Property owners who use this service with their lender are responsible for ensuring that the mortgage company receives a copy of the tax bill and pays the appropriate amount due. If your company issues you a check, make sure to endorse the back. If the payment received is larger than your total tax bill, then you will receive a refund. Refunds will be issued within 30 days.

## LOTTERY & GAMING PROPERTY TAX CREDIT

- This property tax credit is given to WI residents who owned their home as of Jan 1, 2023 or who purchased a home after Jan 1 that was the primary residence of the previous owner and will be the primary residence of the new owner.
- This credit cannot be claimed on commercial property and a property owner can only claim one primary residence in Wisconsin.
- If you are eligible for the credit in 2023, but do not see it listed on your tax bill visit: [www.revenue.wi.gov](http://www.revenue.wi.gov) and search "Lottery Credit Form" or contact the City Clerk for assistance.
