ANIMAL LICENSES

- Licenses are required for all dogs and cats five months of age or older by March 31st.
- A copy of the **PROOF OF RABIES** certificate for each pet is required to obtain a license.
- FEES are \$6 per neutered/spayed animals or \$15 for each unaltered animal. A \$5 late fee will be charged for all licenses issued after March 31st except newly acquired pets.

Where Do My Taxes Go?



During 2022, the City of Dodgeville under went a State required "revaluation". By more fairly assessing properties based on recent market conditions, the City saw a shift of taxes away from properties classified as "commercial" and onto those assessed as "residential". The average increase of total assessed value of all classes was 35%. Overall, the net mill rate of ALL taxing jurisdictions (school, tech school, county & city) dropped from \$27.79/\$1,000 in 2021 to \$21.64/\$1,000 in 2022.

This includes pet licenses, utility payments, or other fees due to the City. **Please write separate checks for each service.** If you include more than your property tax payment, your check will be refused & you will be required to issue a new check.

PROPERTY TAX REMINDERS

- First installment tax payments are payable to the <u>City of Dodgeville</u> by January 31, 2022. Second installment payments are due to <u>Iowa County</u> by July 31, 2023.
- All personal property taxes, except improvements on leased land, are due in full by January 31st.
- If the total tax due on a parcel is \$100 or less, the full amount is due by January 31st. (See Wis \$74.11(7) or \$74.12 or \$74.5)
- Failure to Pay On Time If you choose to pay your real estate taxes in installments, then you must pay each installment timely or the TOTAL amount of your remaining unpaid taxes, special assessments, special charges and special taxes (if any) will be delinquent (§74.11(7) or §74.12 or §74.87) All delinquent taxes are subject to interest rate of 1% plus .5% penalty rate per month (a fraction of a month counts as a whole month) from Feb 1 until paid. Failure to receive a tax bill does not relieve the obligation of the property owner to pay taxes.
- Escrow Payments—Property owners who use this service with their lender are responsible for ensuring that the mortgage company receives a copy of the tax bill and pays the appropriate amount due. If your company issues you a check, make sure to endorse the back. If the payment received is larger than your total tax bill, then you will receive a refund. Refunds will be issued within 30 days.

LOTTERY & GAMING PROPERTY TAX CREDIT

- This property tax credit is given to WI residents who owned their home as of Jan 1, 2022 or who purchased a home after Jan 1 that was the primary residence of the previous owner and will be the primary residence of the new owner.
- This credit cannot be claimed on commercial property and a property owner can only claim one primary residence in Wisconsin.
- If you are eligible for the credit in 2022, but do not see it listed on your tax bill visit: www.revenue.wi.gov and search "Lottery Credit Form" or contact the City Clerk for assistance.
