- B. Economic Development
 - 1. Accept Proposal for Dodgeville Business Park Development Analysis and Marketing

Economic Development Specialist Steve Genoway presented the Dodgeville Business Park Development Analysis and Marketing Proposals received and the recommendation of the review team, which consisted of Public Works Director Greg Lee, Building Inspector/Assessor Randy Edge, and Economic Development Specialist Steve Genoway. The proposals were as follows:

Vierbicher Associates, Inc. - \$11,000 - with a timeline of 3.25 months

Jewell Associates Engineers, Inc. - \$11,750 with a timeline of 3 months

MSA Professional Services, Inc. - \$15,200 with a timeline of 4-6 months

The review team recommended Viericher based on their demonstrated ability to perform the services, local experience, responsiveness to the objectives in the RFP, and confidence in their proposed plan and timeline. Vierbicher also proposed the most efficient cost. Genoway reminded the Council that \$10,000 of the cost is covered by the grant from Iowa County and the other \$1,000 is accounted for in the Economic Development marketing budget of the City. Motion by Ald. DeVoss to approve the recommendation to accept the proposal for the Dodgeville Business Park Development Analysis and Marketing for \$11,000 as presented. Ald. Sersch questioned if there is a need for the services, at this time. Some discussion followed. Second by Ald. Mainwaring. Motion passed 6-1, with Ald. Forseth voting nay and Ald. Johnson excused.
