Computer Software and Services Contract with Civic Systems, LLC

A contract was reviewed for the purchase of General Ledger, Payroll, Utilities, Cash Receipting, AR/AP software, and "Software for Life" for a total estimate of \$77,750. The City will be invoiced \$6,000 upon the effective date of the contract, followed by 3 year payment schedule: \$23,917 in January 2018, \$23,917 in January 2019, and \$23,916 in January 2020.
