The numbers presented at the previous meeting were plugged in and approximately \$62,000 needed to be cut. It was decided to pull \$18,000 for the pool plastering; \$15,000 for police SUV; \$30,000 increase for a fire truck was removed (still setting aside the usual \$50,000).
