- A. Discussion and Possible Action on Ordinance 2022-02: Repeal and Recreate Section 7.145 of the Municipal Code of the City of Dodgeville, Iowa County, Wisconsin, Relating to All-Terrain Vehicle and Utility Terrain Vehicle Operation and Routes and Establishing Penalties for Violation Thereof

City Attorney Eric Hagen reviewed the proposed ATV/UTV ordinance. He explained the City can't be more restrictive anything beyond what the State Statutes require. If the ordinance was to pass, it would not be in effect until everything is properly signed and after appropriate publication.

The Mayor reviewed a map of the City showing proposed streets that would remain closed.

A question was asked regarding if the round-a-bout at Bennett Rd and US 18 should be allowed to stay open. Club members stated that other communities with round-a-bouts do not have issues. Other concerns addressed were access to gas stations and posted speed limits. Pat Seiling asked what ATV/UTVs would gain by being able to be allowed to access downtown Dodgeville.

PW Director Lee addressed the Club regarding assisting with sign costs if the ordinance were to pass. The Club plans on assisting with these costs.

Motion by Meuer, second by Weber to approve Ordinance 2022-02 relating to ATV/UTV operation within the City of Dodgeville with the round-a-bout being open at Bennett Rd and US 18. Roll call vote. Motion carried 7-0. The ordinance can be reviewed and revised as necessary if problems arise in the future.
