## II. Agenda Items

1. Police Dept Request to Use Carryover Funds for Firearms Purchase

Police Chief David Bauer and Lieutenant Brandon Wilhelm addressed the Committee regarding the need for purchasing new firearms for the Dodgeville Police Department. They are requesting to use department carryover funds for the purchase. The Police Department has had the 1911 Smith and Wesson firearms for the past ten years and no longer have an armorer on staff to service the weapons. They attempted to send their firearms instructor to a recent armorer school, but the class was cancelled due to a lack of Police Departments carrying this type of weapon for duty. They are looking to replace their existing weapons with Springfield XD Mod2 firearms. They anticipate the cost to be approximately \$8,247.49, which will be offset by the sales of the 1911 firearms (to current officers at approximately \$450 a piece - totaling \$4,950). The out of pocket costs would be approximately \$3,297.49.

Discussion regarding the sale price of the 1911 Smith and Wesson firearms. It was suggested the price could range from \$350-\$450 since staff is interested in purchasing the firearms. Discussion regarding the potential latitude of the sale price for the officers.

Motion by Forseth to recommend approval of the Police Department request to use carryover funds for firearms purchase and recommend authorization to sell/dispose of old equipment. Second by Sersch. Motion passed unanimously.
